Actions from last meeting:

- Results of Growing Crops Competition are posted on the notice board.

- Following the vaulting of the gate by a "scrap dealer" the association will fund an extension to the top rail of the gate by the shop. Mick Poynton to complete work.
- Work has started to clear the weeds on the overgrown plot mentioned last month.

Matters discussed at this meeting:

- The gate is being left open and the site left unsecured. Often this is a result of people requesting the gate been left open for their departure. The gate must only left open for others if they are visibly ready to leave the car park.
- When rent is paid, ploholders with overgrown plots will be told to clear their weeds. If this is not done, a letter will be sent giving them 28 days to comply.
