	It has been confirmed that trees posing a continued Health and Safety risk to the site are the responsibility of the Council to maintain.	The recent Council visit to inspect the trees concluded that they will be cut back at some point from September 2019 onwards. A cherry picker will be brought onto the site to facilitate this.
	It was noted that the wood chip that was supposed to be delivered by the council has still not materialised.	Wood chip provision from the Council is not forthcoming at the moment. We aim to continue sourcing a free supply from other providers whenever possible.
	Concerns regarding the potential for flooding from the brook remain. It is not yet clear who will take ultimate responsibility to clear the debris between the brook on the site and Lichfield Road.	No further update. We need to raise the issue with the person who has taken over from Clive (Jas).
	The shed on plot 1 needs to be removed as it poses a health and safety risk.	To be removed ASAP.
	Boundaries on some plots are in a very poor state of repair. The boundary from one of the plots was falling into the roadway.	Alan Lines will follow this up.
	Water points have been fixed. New taps and flexi- hoses fitted as required.	
	Some of the notice boards are in a poor state of repair.	New notice boards have been made and will be sited by the work party in the near future.
	Disposal of rubbish;	
	Quotes have been obtained to remove the ever growing composting pile. £250 per 16 tonnes.	Alan Lines to action removal of the 'composting' heaps. Going forward, every plot holder will be expected to have a composting area on their own plot.

	It was agreed that once the polytunnel has been cleared, we will pay for all unwanted plastic and glass to be removed from the site.
